The new bus, which was customized to accommodate two wheel chairs and a specialized lift, was made possible through a generous gift of \$67,000 from an anonymous donor. Jacquelyn M. Glock, MSW, the Director of Development for the Windmill Alliance, Inc., said, “We are overwhelmingly grateful to this generous donor. It was an honor to be considered for such a large gift.”

The Rev. Gregory G. Perez, President of the Windmill Alliance, Inc., said, “This gift will make it possible for our residents with physical challenges to live fuller, more productive lives. The new bus can make the difference in enabling our participants to remain in their own home community.”

The new vehicle boasts the latest safety and design features and is completely ADA-compliant. Frank DiPillo, Transportation Manager for the Windmill, said that the new bus is easy to drive and safely and comfortably transports passengers with physical disabilities.

Programs of the Windmill Alliance, Inc. include the Windmill Center, a day training program for participants with developmental disabilities; the Supervised Apartments, which is a residential program for adults with disabilities; and H.I.G.H.W.A.Y.S., the thrift store, emergency food pantry and job training and counseling program.
